Stone of the Five Eras



Original Stone

-Discovered in 1790 during repairs on Mexico City's Cathedral.
-It is a 12' diameter carved Mexica sculpture created by the Aztecs. It weighs 24 tons.



-The exact use of this large carved sculpture is still debated.

Original Stone

- -At the center is the 5th sun: Tonatiah
- -Around the sun's face are
- 4 other sun periods:
 - -Jaguar Era
 - -Wind/Hurricane Era
 - -Rain of Fire Era
 - -Water/Flood Era



Original Stone

The "glyphs" or pictographs around the center face may represent cycles of the earth or the days of a month.
It could also represent space as well as time, depicting the 4 corners of the earth.
