He was:

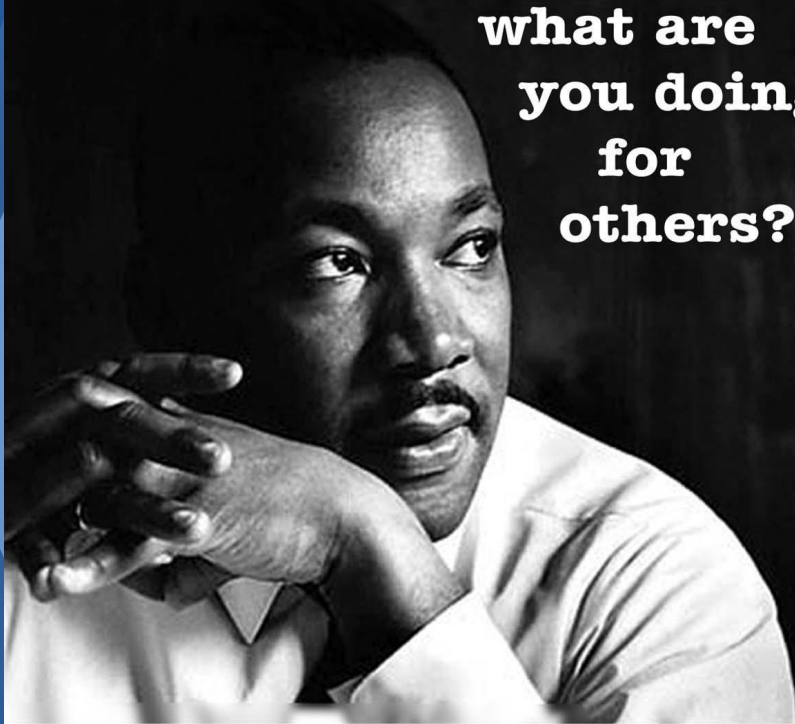
An American pastor

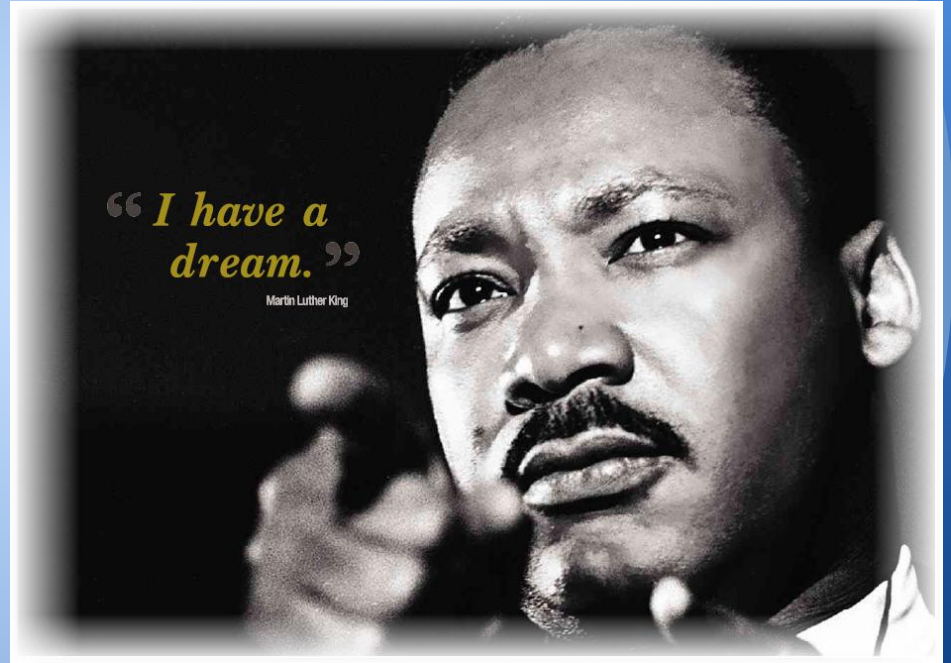


His Dream:

potential.



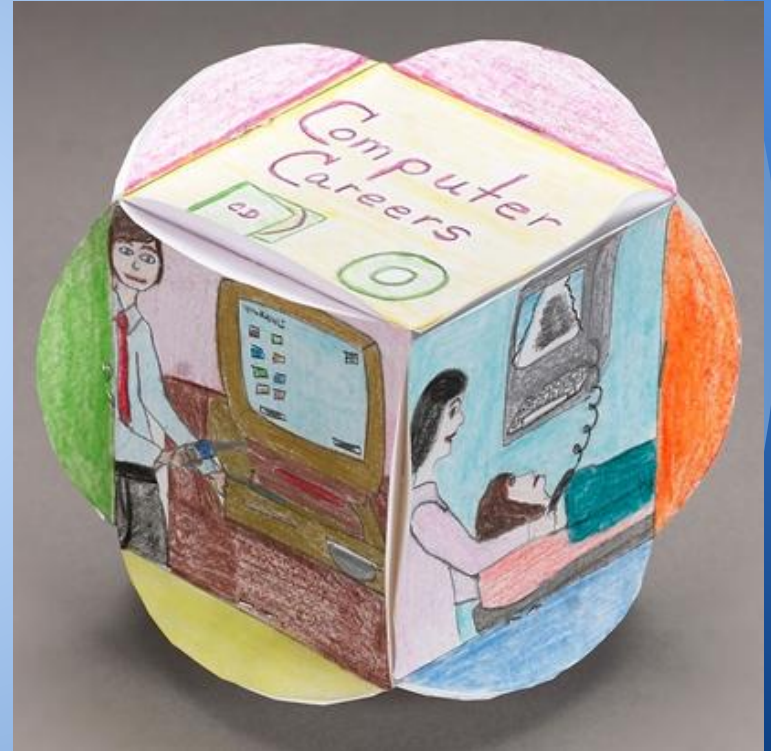
To ACHIEVE that DREAM:

It is never too early to be thinking about our careers and going to college.



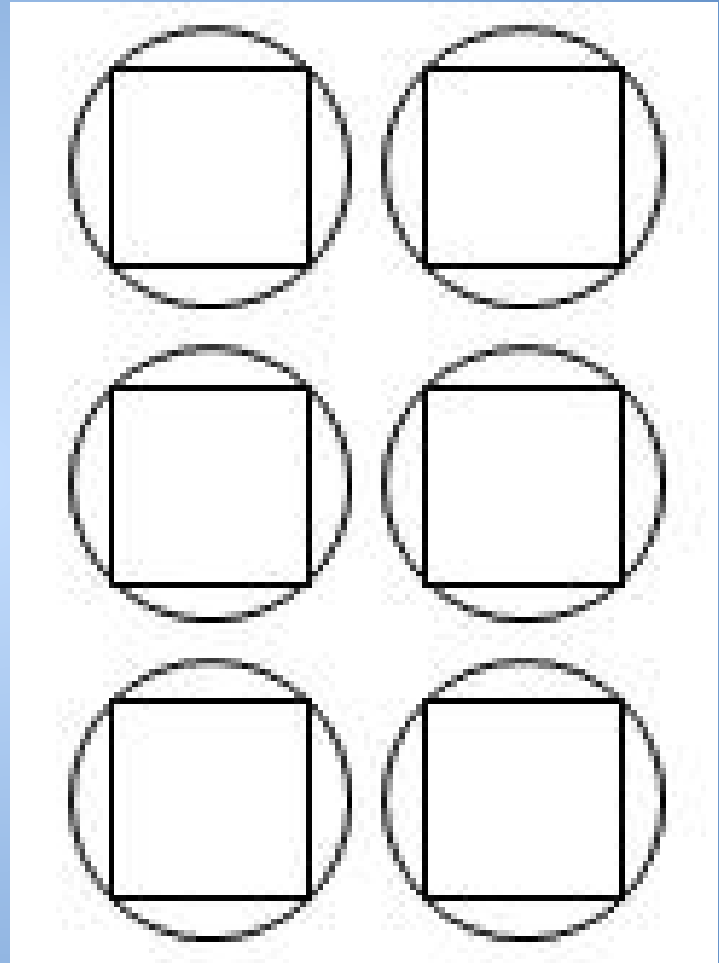
Today's OBJECTIVE:

To draw, color in and design our own Dream Box/Career Cube which shows the jobs we would like to do to share our lives and work with others.



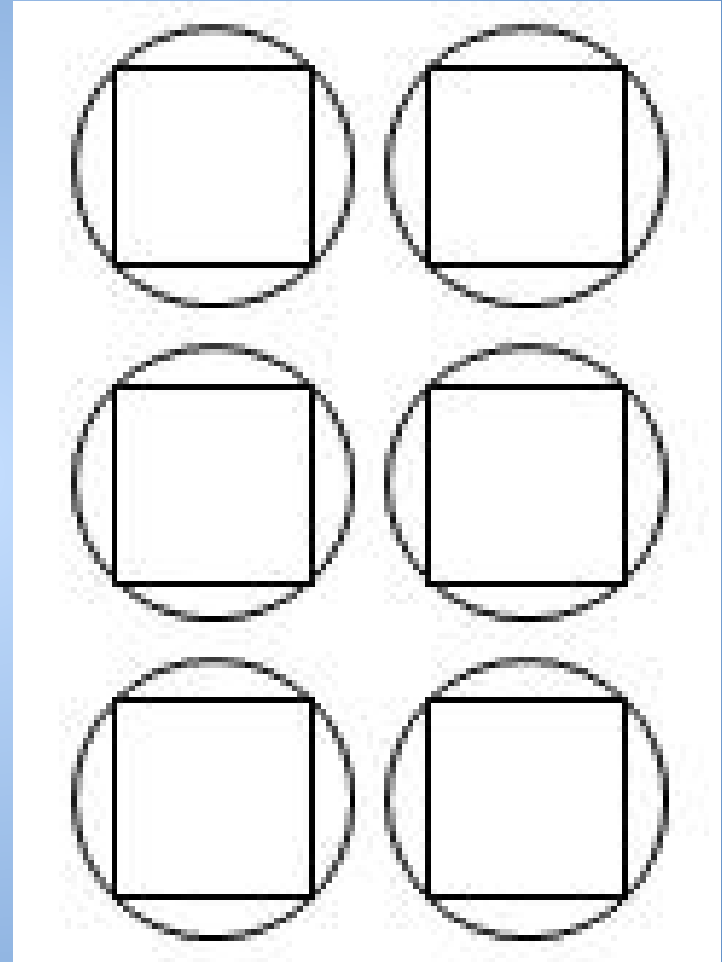
We will start:

Using pencil, draw a picture in each square about your career.

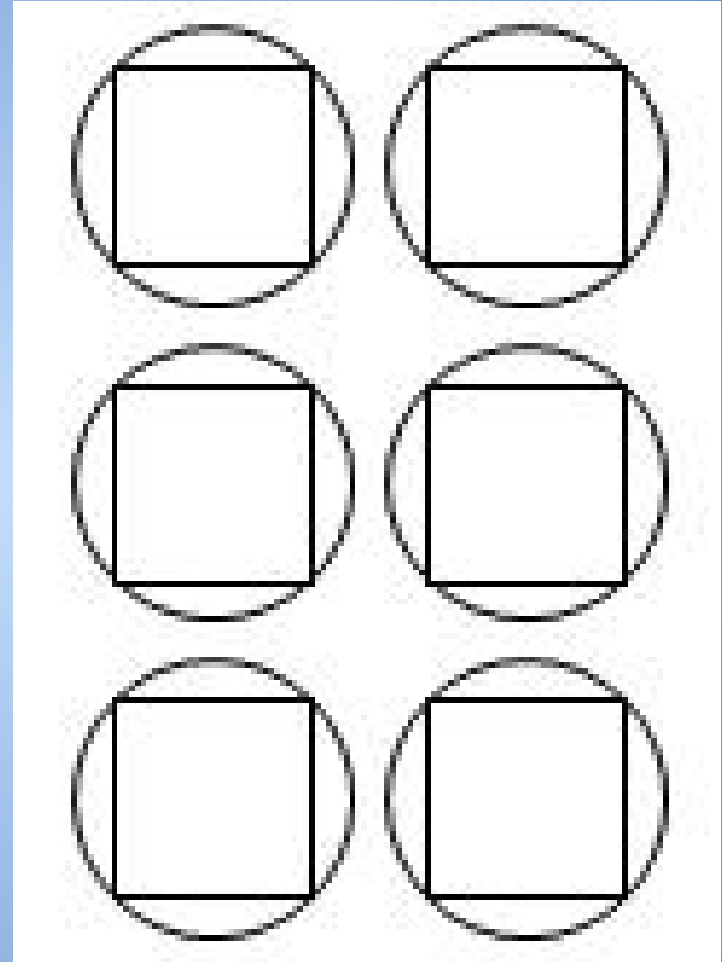


We will start:
