#### **Louise Nevelson**

She was born in 1899 in the Ukraine and died in 1988 in New York City. She was a prominent American sculptor who made large "monochromatic" sculptures.

#### "Monochromatic"

Monochromatic means one color scheme. In Louise Nevelson's case, that was work which was primarily all black or all white.








#### **Our Job Today**


