

Exploring Personal Symbolism in Art


Brainstorming:

Color Meanings:

- Silver / White: Signifies truth, sincerity, peace, innocence and purity.
- Gold: Signifies wisdom, generosity, glory, constancy and faith.
- Black: Signifies wisdom, grief, constancy and prudence.
- Green: Signifies abundance, joy, hope and loyalty in love.
- Blue: Signifies loyalty, chastity, truth, strength and faith.
- Red: Signifies magnanimity, military strength, warrior and martyr.
- Purple: Signifies purpose, temperance, regal, justice, royal majesty, and sovereignty.
- Maroon / Blood Red: Signifies Fortitude or victorious.
- Orange Tawny: Signifies ambition.
